
Distance Education


Distance Training

Training is much more about skills and the ability to use them autonomously.

As such, providing distance training requires that a **specific learning experience** is created remotely. Interaction between instructors, participants, software, machinery must be in place in a way where distance does not matter.

Training a single remote learner

In its simplest form, the video tutorial breaks the distance by using tools like Skype, TeamViewer, Adobe Connect, etc.



Remote training audience Linked training rooms may allow a live training experience to be shared with two audiences




